

A La Plagne exclusive and world premiere: 2 cabins guite unlike the others will be added to the recently opened Les Glaciers gondola that climbs to the new arrival point Live **3000**, 3,080 m above sea level. Designed by La Plagne and developed by lift constructor POMA, the minimalist cabins are open to the elements to take you to the peak with the wind in your hair.

Passengers are harnessed and attached by a lifeline, in direct contact with the environment through the slatted floor and glassless windows! The lift takes you right to the very peak of La Plagne and a striking Alpine rooftop, with a panoramic terrace and Le Sixième Ciel café.

GOING #SOLO BUT NOT ALONE

There are so many benefits to reconnecting with ourselves, of taking quality time for ourselves, which has become a luxury in our ultra-filled lives. A new-found freedom, including the choice of whether we want to share an experience or not.

GETTING TOGETHER IN A REFUGE

When it comes to introspection and getting back to basics, a mountain refuge is the place to be, where sustainable sobriety is combined with an exceptional setting.

There are no less than seven refuges across La Plagne, each with its own personality that is inseparable from that of its wardens. With a front–row seat to the consequences of global warming, refuges are outposts as regards respect of resources and best tourism practices: showers (possibly cold) are on a timer, the food is very local, the cooking "homemade" and the Wi–Fi depends on the solar panel's goodwill.

We can disconnect in the truest sense of the word, without sacrificing the pleasure of enjoying some time to ourselves, or sharing it if we prefer, particularly during meals eaten around the shared table, or entertainment on musical or nature themes.

TRAVELLING SOLO... WITH A DONKEY

Enduring and (mostly) silent, the donkey's main job is to carry your bags to the refuge (35 kg max). However, as the kilometres go by, the animal's company proves to be more beneficial than it first appears: **obstacles overcome together, spontaneous exchanges with other hikers surprised at this pairing** and a mutual benevolence that encourages your body and mind to keep moving forward.

#E-COMMODATION

A mix of "eco" and "accommodation", this refers to accommodation committed to reducing its impact. Refuges even take the concept to the level of "regenerative tourism", i.e. leaving the place in a better state that you found it, by taking rubbish down, for example.

WHEN DETOX CURES HIT RESET

Combining fasting + hiking is the secret of these one-week courses designed to detox your body and mind. In Champagny-en-Vanoise, they are organised by the family-run company Chemin de la Santé, based in 4 exceptional locations in France. Motivation varies from one participant to another and may simply come from the need to take a break.

Very tangible health benefits (cholesterol, hypertension, aches, allergies, etc.) result in about half of the participants coming back every year, usually on their own. The cures are supervised by the structure's naturopaths. The Champagny-le-Haut site was chosen in 2014 for the beauty of its calm, cool setting... and its distance from the gourmet temptations of urban locations!

NEW HUTTOPIA CAMPSITE

The campsite in Champagny-en-Vanoise has been given a facelift! With its skill for finding little gems of sites, Huttopia, the creator of ecotourism accommodation, was won over by the site's potential.

The quintessence of mountain camping, the spirit remains intact: a small campsite that respects the surrounding natural environment, with particular attention paid to the 100 pitches and 15 canvas and wood tents that are "ready for camping", nothing more, nothing less! The campsite is set in the heart of a larch forest on the banks of the river Doron.

As regards services, the essentials of the "Huttopia touch" are all there: bread delivery, essential groceries and fully renovated washrooms, as well as a common area with board games, ping-pong tables, Molkky, etc.

The wow factor of the mountain views is the main argument, as everyone agrees (even the locals, who can't get enough of it!). The village of Champagny-en-Vanoise looks very small down below. So near and yet so far from everyday life, the gîte is just a 10-minute drive down a small, unpaved road.

On the first floor of a family-owned stone mountain chalet, it has several trump cards up its sleeve: a "natural garden" just outside the door, and a huge 40 m² terrace that is perfect for chilling out. Having the owners just upstairs is a real plus if you need local recommendations and the wood-burning stove is just the thing for cooler evenings!

NIGHT-TIME HORSE RIDING

A great idea for continuing from day into night. On horseback, in the dark, you paradoxically discover the Champagny-le-Haut valley in a whole new light. The relationship between rider and horse is even stronger because, at night, while the rider no longer recognizes anyone on their Henson* horse, the horse can see very well in the dark! Trusting your horse is the key to this unifying experience, that is often a first for most members of the group.

From 8pm to 11:30pm: riding at dusk, aperitif in a clearing with exclusively local products (sausage, Beaufort and Tomme cheese and rosé wine) returning by night.

* The horses at Chalet des Vignobles equestrian farm are sand-coloured Henson horses, excellent companions for equestrian tourism.

THE EVENT **SUPER8 - 12 TO 14 JULY 2024**

A multi-discipline bike event, with a wide range of courses for all levels, timed or not, with or without electric assistance and, particularly, in tight-fitting or baggy cycle shorts... in short, an event with no discrimination! The common denominator is the quality of the routes proposed that are chosen so you always get to see the best of the area, both in the bike park and on the trails that are unveiled for the occasion. Jérôme Gilloux, three-time e-MTB World Cup champion is the event's ambassador of choice.

What sets this event apart from other similar events? Definitely its Grand8 e-MTB event that takes place over 2 days and involves battery management strategy and a bivouac. An event where big names mingle with amateur enthusiasts and the routes are designed for and by riders. Two-time e-MTB world vice-champion Hugo Pigeon won the 2023 edition.

A winning land and water combo for mountain bikers who love to descend: after riding down 1,500 m through the forest to the valley on a mountain bike, the adventure continues as you raft down the river Isère, still making the most of the effect of gravity. Cooling off in the river water is the best method of muscle recovery!

DOWNHILL MOUNTAIN BIKING CAMP FOR TEENS WITH UCPA

A week of total immersion in mountain biking for 13 to 17 year-olds. Equipped with the appropriate protection (full-face helmet, back protectors, knee pads), the participants learn or improve their skills over the week. Descents, jumps, balance, braking and steering are tackled progressively. The aim is to enjoy riding on all the different types of terrain in La Plagne's bike playgrounds (the bike park trails for all levels, the pump track at Plagne Bellecôte and even a day of freeriding all over the resort). The bonus is the UCPA jump area equipped with an airbag, so you can learn to jump safely.



ADAPTABILIS EXHIBITION: A HABITABLE PLANET FOR LIVING THINGS



4 July to 22 September, 2024

Put together by eco-artist Laurence Piaget-Dubuis and architect/ urban planner Hervé Savioz, this exhibition in Aime's Montmayeur tower invites us to question the habitability of territories in the face of climate challenges and receding glaciers. Through an immersive photographic installation, the Swiss duo, with their sensitivity to the Alpine environment, open negotiations on how to adapt, adjust and agree on new cohabitation relationships between human and non-human living things, and co-write the stories of a shared future. Wandering through the 7 alcoves offers an experience that takes us from the past to the future and leads us to question the present.

AIMING AT "ZERO WASTE ON THE MOUNTAIN BY 2030"

Reducing waste, raising awareness, collecting and assessing: these are the key words that will lead us towards our goal of a clean, waste-free mountain. A priority that La Plagne is tackling through a number of actions and always with the support of the Mountain Riders association as the figurehead:

SIGNATORY OF THE "ZERO WASTE IN THE MOUNTAINS BY 2030" CHARTER

Uncontrolled pollution in the mountains has an impact on the aquatic ecosystems and biodiversity of the whole planet. An essential player in terms of water cycle sources, the mountain regions are uniting in their undertaking to achieve zero uncontrolled waste in the mountains by 2030. Through this undertaking, the regions' public and private players intend to make the mountains the only territory free of any uncontrolled pollution. La Plagne has



signed this charter and is thereby committing to implementing the resulting action plan.

A collaborative scientific approach approved by the French Ministry of Ecological Transition that consists of carrying out biannual collections for 3 years on the same site, with the same number of people. The aim is to measure the development of un-

CIRCULAR ECONOMY

INNOVATION IN THE MOUNTAIN **PASTURES BY TRANSFORMING** WHEY INTO METHANE

As regards waste, the only small thing about "le petit lait" (whey) is its name, since 500,000 litres of it is produced over the summer in Plan Pichu mountain pasture! This residue is created during the manufacture of Beaufort cheese and represents 90% of the volume of milk produced. Since summer 2023, the local farmers have taken things in hand by transforming the whey into methane, a first in the mountain pastures! The aim is to create a circular economy since the whey is not merely recycled but is actually transformed into energy to heat the water and milk.

LOCAL CARPOOLING STRATEGY



To limit the impact of short, regular journeys (e.g. home-to-work or home-to-study), all the BlaBlaCar communities of the Savoie municipalities have signed a contract with Blablacar Daily to encourage carpooling. In this concept, the driver is

compensated and passengers travel for free.

The initiative has been widely embraced in La Plagne, which has observed in its latest greenhouse gas report that 17% of the 3% of greenhouse gas emissions generated by local authorities can be attributed to business travel. The goal is to go from 1.4 to 2 seats occupied per car.

PRECIOUS DROPS OF WATER

MAINTAINING THE CANALS ON THE VERSANT DU SOLEIL

The irrigation canals dug by men into the ground and the rock are specific to the mountains and a legacy of the collective intelligence of our elders! A whole network of these canals transports and distributes the water through gravity from the mountain peaks to meet the different requirements, ranging from irrigation of the pastures, meadows and gardens to drinking water for domestic and wild animals. They act as a bulwark against global warming by creating wetlands that store and release the water.

Their maintenance is essential, a real act of solidarity and civic responsibility. Equipped with small saws, secateurs, shovels and pickaxes, anyone can join in the work, even children.

These open days for everyone, locals and visitors alike, are scheduled for 25 May and 22 June, 2024, to maintain the canals on the Versant du Soleil.


